


Katherine A. Kendall Institute Request for Proposal

FluidReview Instructions

Step 1: Sign in to the review system at <https://cswe.fluidreview.com>.



If it is your first time accessing the FluidReview system, click “Sign Up.” Please note that this account is not linked to your CSWE membership account. Fill out your information (photo not required) and click “Register.” Once you’ve created an account, there may be a slight delay in receiving the e-mail to confirm registration. Click on the link in your e-mail to activate your account.

Step 2: After signing in, click the “Start” button to access the eligibility requirements.
